PRINCIPAL'S SOAPBOX

Welcome to Book Week. We have many exciting activities happening in the school related to the love of books and reading. Our book fair starts on Monday and the children will be going through the library to view new books. The Library will be open for parents to purchase books and or/donate books to our school library. Educational Update

Survey Update - Information via the survey showed some concerns around the use of Maths Whizz in the classroom context. Maths Whizz is a programme that we are trialling in two classes as a major support to mathematics learning. Across the school it is used as a support programme as part of a whole class rotation programme. For example; students will be working with a teacher, a group will be completing follow up activities and others will be reinforcing their learning using Math Whizz. Because we are able to track progress, pinpointing specific areas of weakness through the use of Math Whizz, teachers are quickly able to remedy learning deficiencies and assist students with remedial support timely and with accuracy. We are finding Math Whizz is also supporting the learning of strand maths, measurement, geometry, and statistics allowing us to focus on numeracy knowledge and strategy. We will be aiming at having another information evening either this term or in term 4 to provide evidence of Maths Whizz success in classes, ways we teach mathematics in the school and also ways in which you can assist us at home with mathematical learning.
