### **Educational Update.**

Hekia Parata has made another statement that appears to be extreme and this is why in an election year we need to be aware of the issues currently being tabled. First it was the executive principal leading to the possibility of Boards of Trustees and community voice being limited in how a school should be run and now it is funding schools based on data. When schools are struggling with large social and economic issues of course their data is not going to be as 'high' as those in more affluent areas where, generally, children have a better start to life. It is said that a child's achievement depends on a wide range of factors including whether they were living in a cold, damp house and whether their parents were educated and make time to spend with them. Taking money from schools that are already struggling and giving it to the ones that are already doing well will not raise student achievement. We need to find a remedy to our rising inequalities and social issues and throwing more money at schools where data achievement is already at a prime will not raise the achievement of our lesser performing neighbours.

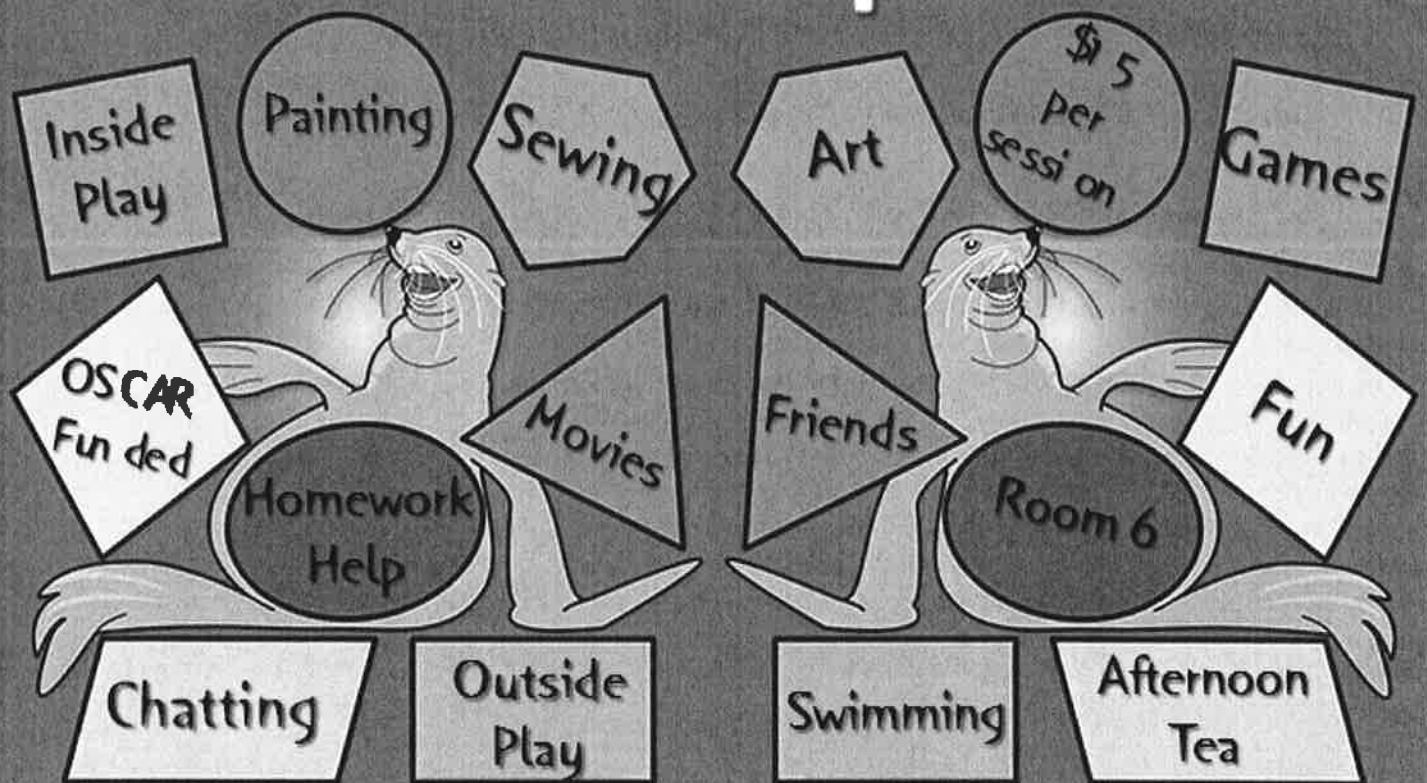

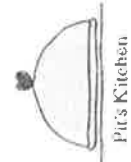

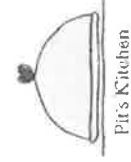
