Head Lice. Head lice have been found and reported in all syndicates. Over the school holiday break, please check ALL members of your family for lice (yes, Mum and Dad can have them too), and treat if lice are present. Treat not just once, but for the next two weeks following the initial treatment in order to completely break the life cycle of the lice. Chemical nit treatments and natural products are available and wet combing can also be effective although time consuming. Head Lice is a community problem that unfortunately is made worse when children get together at school. Please check your children's hair regular especially if you see them scratching. Treat as soon as lice are found in order to help keep infestations at bay.

GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING

Absences. Children not attending school must be reported to the school office before **9.30am with the reason for the absence.** You can either leave a message on our answering service 09-431-4385 or text the school mobile 0223957708. ***YOU MUST CONTACT THE SCHOOL EACH DAY YOUR CHILD IS AWAY.***

School Buses. Buses are provided to take children to and from their home. With over 300 students to organise on buses in the afternoon, it is imperative that the office keeps an accurate check list of children riding the bus home in the afternoon in case of an accident or emergency. Please let the office know if your child is not on their normal bus in the afternoon **before 2:00pm.**

Visiting the School Grounds. If you are visiting the school for any reason you need to first sign in at the school office and obtain a visitors pass – this is a health and safety requirement.

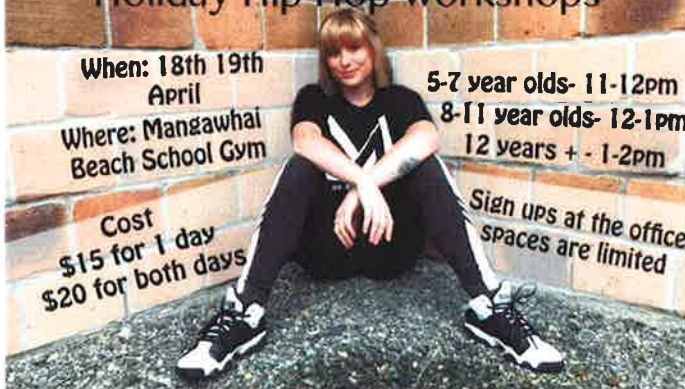
