PRINCIPAL'S SOAPBOX

Today we welcomed by Powhiri Sonya Smith to the best school in Northland. Sonya is our amazingly talented new entrant teacher in room 2. She is starting another new entrant class as our school roll continues to grow. It is exciting to see the positive way our school continues to grow. I would like to take the opportunity in this newsletter to thank the amazing work my leaders and teachers have been doing throughout the school to promote teaching and learning and effective behaviour. We are seeing positive progress in all areas in the school especially in behaviour and attitudes towards learning. It is wonderful to see the progress in learning and the way in which you, our parents, are supporting us with learning at home - thank you.

On Thursday 20th June the Senior syndicate is travelling to the Auckland Museum. We wish them a safe and enjoyable trip.

Disco - Tickets for the school disco go on sale this week. The Disco is on Friday 21st June. Tickets are \$5 and this entitles the children to entry and a sausage and drink. The Junior Disco (Yr 1-4) starts at 5.30pm through to 6.30pm and the Senior Disco (Yr 5-8) starts at 7:00pm and goes till 8:30pm. The theme for both Disco's is Super Heros.

Wellsford Sports Exchange - Selected children have been busy training on Friday's to compete against Wellsford Primary School on Friday the 28th June. This is a time for our talented sportsmen and woman to show off their expertise and win for their school. It will be a great day of competition and parents are welcome to come and watch.

Rippa Tournament - Lance Coker will be selecting the teams this week for the Y 3/4 and Y 5/6 Kaiwaka Rippa challenge on Friday 21st June. A note regarding this event will be sent out to parents shortly.

Bus Behaviour expectations - We have many students that use the bus service before and after school each day. A majority of these children display fantastic values and follow the school's expectations. The school appreciates these students and thanks them for their mature decision making. There was a bus meeting with all these students earlier in the week to congratulate the students for great bus behaviour. In this meeting it was also made clear that any student who cannot follow our expectations will lose the privilege of using the bus service for a set amount of time. If your child uses the bus please remind them the school expects students to be responsible while waiting for the bus, sit down on the bus for the entire ride home and display respect on the bus.

Home Time Messages: We are getting an increasing number of parents calling the office with home time messages for their children. We appreciate that emergency situations do arise and that is what the home time message system is for. The school will ensure that children are given messages and arrive at their destination safely however, we are asking parents/caregivers to be proactive in after school arrangements for their children and make sure their child has clear instructions about what is to happen after school. The office has been fielding in excess of 20 home time messages per day from parents who are changing non essential after school routines for their children which is interfering with the day to day running of the school office. Your assistance in reducing these non essential phone calls would be appreciated.

What's on this fortnight -



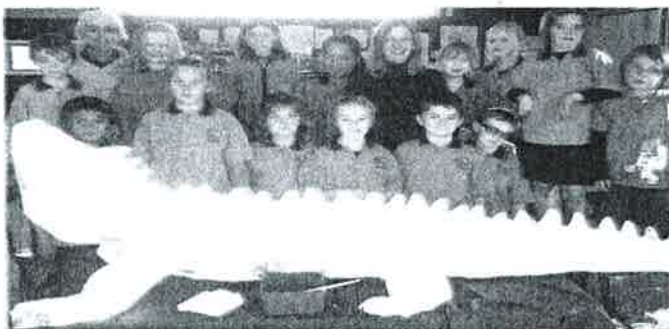

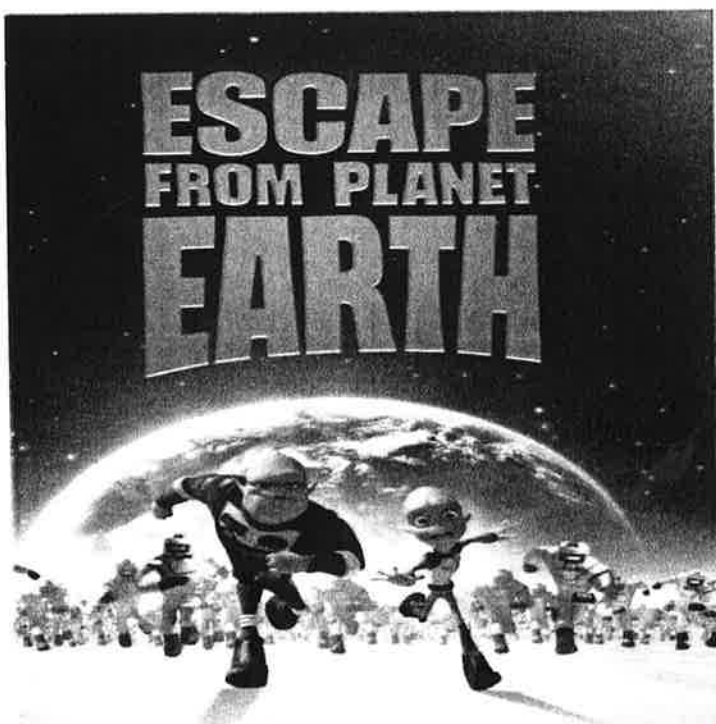
Hi, we are after a club administrator to do the administrative duties for the Mangawhai Heads Volunteer Lifeguard Service.
