PRINCIPAL'S SOAPBOX

Welcome back to term three. We have a very exciting term ahead so please keep your eye on our



calendar, facebook events and bookmark key dates of interest. Term three is always a busy term and starts with next **Friday (6th August)** being a Parent/Teacher interview day between 9am-6pm. Due to the size of our school we have decided to **close for instruction** to allow

teachers to complete parent-student teacher interviews. That means there will be no regular classes scheduled for Friday 6th August while interviews are being conducted. We ask that you please bring your child/children along to the interviews (in school uniform) to discuss their recent report, their academic and social progress and to relay to our teachers any concerns you may have. The following week from the 9-13 August is our whole school book week. During this week we

We look forward to seeing all our students dressed in their favourite book characters. As many of you are aware our roading issues become exacerbated when school is back in action. As a school we have spoken with the council and are trying to come up with solutions to the one lane backup currently running in Moir Street. Causeway Church has offered the car park on Leslie Street as a possible drop off pick up point for parents. There is a shortcut from Leslie Street through to Halyard Way onto the school for children to walk through. This may be an option that you may choose to negotiate with your children for safe pick up and drop off. In the meantime we will continue to offer our drop off zone at school in the gym car park until the roading and parking issues have been resolved. Alternatively you could drop off and pick up your child at the Mangawhai Domain. This is another option that has been muted.

We are very excited this year to be sending a group of Intermediate students to the AIMS games.

- Leggings must be black and are permitted under skorts or culottes (but not worn on their own)

- Polar fleece or merino jumpers are to be worn not sweatshirts or other non uniforms jackets
- School beanies/caps only
- Raincoats of any sort are permitted on wet days.



Students must bring along a note if they are wearing any non uniform items with the reason why. Our teachers are closely monitoring the student's uniforms.




