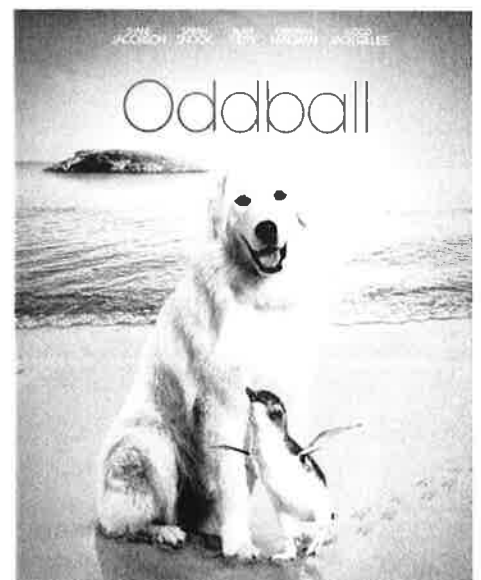

Students competing will be provided with MBS sport shirts to wear for the day. Those playing netball will wear netball uniforms. Students should have appropriate footwear and equipment i.e. mouth guards. We would welcome the support of family members to cheer on the students and Hot Shotz Coffee Trailer will be onsite selling awesome coffee for the spectators - cash only.

Bus Students: It is very difficult in the afternoons for the school to run an efficient bus service when parents are changing their children's after school routines at the last minute. With an extra bus run now in operation it is vital that we get bus 6, bus 1 and bus 3 off as soon as possible after the bell because these buses come back to the school for the bus 2, bus 5 and bus 4 runs. Parents that call with last minute changes create confusion for the bus controllers, parents that turn up right on the bell to collect bus children interrupt roll calls and parents who don't notify the office of bus changes at all cost the school money when we have to call mobile phones to find out why the child hasn't come to bus line. These unnecessary delays hold the buses up for the last three runs of the days which means the children get home later than usual. Moving forward – we require all parents of children who ride buses to provide sufficient notice of changes to bus lists. If you know you are collecting your child, let the office know before 2pm so notes can be sent to class and bus lists can be amended. Remember also that the bus service is only suppose to be used for transport to school and home again – not for playdates and not for rides to sports, or after school activities. We have 287 students to get on buses in the afternoon so please make this job a bit easier for our staff.
