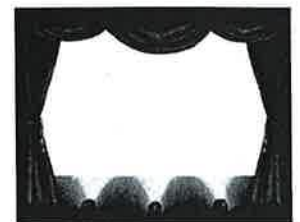

WHOOPING COUGH

The main symptom is a nasty cough that tends to occur in bouts. Sometimes sick people make a "whoop" at the end of the coughing bout. The illness can last for several months. Some parents have called whooping cough "the cough of 100 nights". It can be a dangerous disease for babies and pregnant women.

If your child is coughing please take them to see a doctor. Keep sick children at home and away from other children. Children with whooping cough should not go to preschool or school until, 3 weeks have passed from the start of coughing bouts or, they have stopped coughing or, they have completed 5 days of a course of antibiotics

CHICKENPOX

Chickenpox, also known as varicella, is a highly infectious disease. The early symptoms of chickenpox may include a mild fever, loss of appetite, headache and feeling tired, followed by the appearance of a red rash that becomes itchy blisters mostly on the trunk and face with some on the arms and legs. The blisters release liquid containing the virus and form crusts/scabs that fall off after 1-2 weeks.

The virus can be transferred from person to person through droplets of saliva in the air from coughing, sneezing or laughing. It can also be transferred by direct contact with the liquid from the rash blisters. A person with chickenpox can pass the virus on for 1-2 days before they get the rash until after the rash blisters have dried up, which usually takes 5-7 days.

Children with chickenpox are advised not to attend early childhood, school or public places for at least one week from the appearance of the rash until all the blisters are dry and crusted. Adults are advised not to attend work or public places for the same period of time. **MAKE SURE YOUR CHILDREN ARE UP TO DATE WITH THEIR VACCINATIONS**

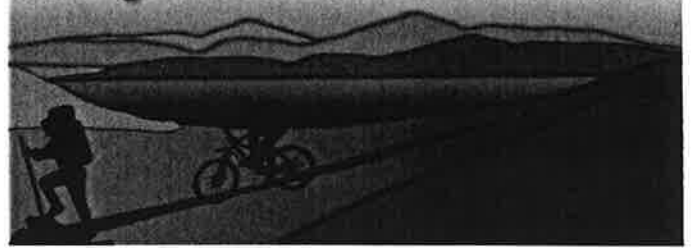
