Resilience: what is it? Basically it is bouncing back from setbacks and trying again. Ever heard the sayings- get back on the horse if it throws you off OR if you fall stand back up, brush yourself off and start again. It is a skill that is lacking in a lot of our children today. Sometimes it is because we as parents are too quick to ride to the rescue. Children need to learn what to do and how to react when things don't go to plan. If they don't, if we always fix things for them, life will be too hard when they become adults. Children need to sort out their own friendship issues, they need to fall over and skin their knees, they need to fail at a test so that they know what to do to overcome these events. The rhyme that the children have at school is **Persevere, pushing through. Bouncing back is what we do. Being strong, not giving up. There is nothing we can't do.** Are you modelling this for your children??

Crossing Supervisors: We have some parent supervisors helping children cross the school carpark in the mornings. A big thank you to this group for helping to keep our children safe. All drivers entering and exiting the carpark should follow the directions of supervisors.

Matariki Week and Move Night: Matariki Week celebrations start on the 18th of June. *Matariki is the name of the Pleiades star cluster. The star cluster was important for navigation and timing the seasons. Traditionally, Matariki was a season to celebrate and to prepare the ground for the coming year. Offerings of the produce of the land were made to the gods, including Rongo, god of cultivated food. This time of the year was also a good time to instruct young people in the lore of the land and the forest. In addition, certain birds and fish were especially easy to harvest at this time.*



After school sports/activities: There are a number of sports groups that practise in and around the school grounds in the afternoon. In the interests of child safety, we recommend students go home before coming back for their sport or a parent supervises them until the coach arrives. Staff are onsite to supervise only those students waiting for late buses.

Students travelling on afternoon buses: We are now doing two roll calls for children going home on buses 2, 4 and 5. If a parent arrives to collect a child from a bus group after the bell, they must first report to the school office who will verify that person is on the permission list to collect the child before reporting to the bus monitor.

In case of emergency: If a situation arises during the day that will change your child's home time routine, we can send a 'green note' to the classroom to advise your child of this change. **Please note this is not for everyday reminders.** Reaffirm after school arrangements with your child in the morning so reminders are not necessary and keep school arrangements consistent so as not to confuse your child.

School Uniforms: Uniform items are sold every Wednesday. You are welcome to come and try on if your child needs a bigger size or just purchase outright. If you would prefer to order and pay online, please send an email to office@mangawhaibeach.school.nz detailing the size, items required and pay directly into the school account (12-3094-0106669-01) with your child's name and 'uniform' as a reference. Garments will be sent home with your child.



Absences. Please advise the office before 9:30am if your child/children are not attending school on any given day. The Ministry of Education requires the reason for the absence. You can either leave a message on our answering service 09-431-4385 or text the school mobile 0223957708. **YOU MUST CONTACT THE SCHOOL EACH DAY YOUR CHILD IS AWAY.**

School Buses. Buses are provided to take children to and from their home not to after school sports/arts or friend's houses for play dates. With more than 300 students to organise on buses in the afternoon, it is important that the office keeps an accurate check list of children riding the bus home in case of an accident or emergency. Please let the office know if your child is not on their normal bus in the afternoon **before 2:00pm**.
