Absences. Children not attending school must be reported to the school office before 9.30am with the reason for the absence. You can either leave a message with our answering service or text the school mobile: 0223957708.

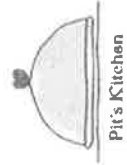
School Buses. Buses are provided to take children to and from their home. Seats are not available to take students to birthday parties, after school activities or play dates. It is imperative that the school keeps a check list of children riding the bus home in case of an accident or emergency. Please let the office know if your child is not on their normal bus in the afternoon.

Head Lice. Head Lice continue to be a problem in some syndicates with students being reinfected on a regular basis. Reinfection occurs when treatments are not done according to directions or not at all. If you get a class letter home to say that head lice have been found in the class PLEASE check your child and treat if required for a minimum of three weeks in order to kill live pests and their eggs that will hatch during the following weeks.

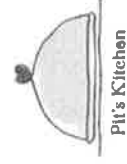

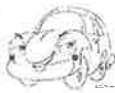
