Trips are planned to reinforce what our students are learning in class. We endeavour to keep the costs to a minimum and appreciate the support from parents to given their children these great out of class experiences.

Health and Wellbeing Survey - On our Facebook and website we have placed a link to the school Health and Wellbeing Survey which we would like our parents to complete. This is a short survey that gives us information on what areas you think are important for us, as a school community, to focus on.

Uniform – We conducted a random spot check of uniforms last week and were pleased to find most of our students wearing the correct uniform - except for socks. A reminder to parents that socks should be black, shoes should be predominately black, and skivvies or tank tops worn underneath uniform shirts should also be black.

Birthday Cakes - A reminder to parents, and advice to our new families that the school has a policy of no birthday cakes for sharing in class. This is because we have children with food allergies and special dietary requirements enrolled. If a shared morning tea/lunch (or our bake sale) is being planned, a notice will be sent home to parents at least one week in advance.

Sore Throats

Strep A throat infections can cause Rheumatic Fever. A simple throat swab is all that is required and if positive then Antibiotic's can be given. This preventable illness is prevalent in Northland and this initiative has been established to help prevent more cases.

This is a free service and free medication will be supplied. Parental consent will be obtained before we can swab or treat your child and your child's GP will be informed of any treatment provided.


Young Ocean Explorers books for sale.

GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING

Absences. Children not attending school must be reported to the school office before **9.30am** with the reason for the absence. You can either leave a message on our answering service 09-431-4385 or text the school mobile 0223957708. YOU MUST CONTACT THE SCHOOL <u>EACH</u> <u>DAY</u> YOUR CHILD IS AWAY.

School Buses. Buses are provided to take children to and from their home. With over 300 students to organise on buses in the afternoon, it is imperative that the office keeps an accurate check list of children riding the bus home in the afternoon in case of an accident or emergency. Please let the office know if your child is not on their normal bus in the afternoon **before 2:00pm**.

Visiting the School Grounds. If you are visiting the school for any reason you need to first log in at the school office and obtain a visitors pass – this is a health and safety requirement.

Home-time Changes (green notes). If an EMERGENCY SITUATION arises during the day and you need to get a message to your child, the office can send a green note with the afternoon messages to let the child know what the change of plan is.

Lost Property. Check lost property on a regular basis for any missing items. At the end of the term any unclaimed items will be given to the St John's Op Shop or sold on the second hand uniform rack as a donation to the school.

Recycle Mobile Phones. There is a drop box in the school office for old mobile phones. Please put your old mobiles in here and not in the rubbish where they end up as land fill.

Introducing the Love Kaipara - Reduce, Reuse, Recycle Education Programme:

At Mangawhai Beach School over two days on the 22 and 25 May 2017, the Love Kaipara education team will teach the year 5s, year 6s and the Enviro Group pupils.

Pupils will learn how to reduce the waste pile by recycling. They will discover which resources go into making glass, plastics, tin, and aluminium, and how long these materials take to decompose if left in nature. These lessons will teach the pupils why it is so important to "Be a Tidy Kiwi".

Parents and whanau, you are welcome to come along to these fun lessons at the school. Lessons will begin around 9:30am. The lessons aim to cover these topics, depending on the time available:

- * Ministry for the Environment figures show 100 million kilos of textile waste is thrown into the country's rubbish dumps yearly. That's the equivalent of every person in New Zealand chucking about 145 mediumsized men's T-shirts a year.
- * Microfibres are responsible for 85% of global shoreline pollution


Keen to make a contribution?
