Principal's Soapbox

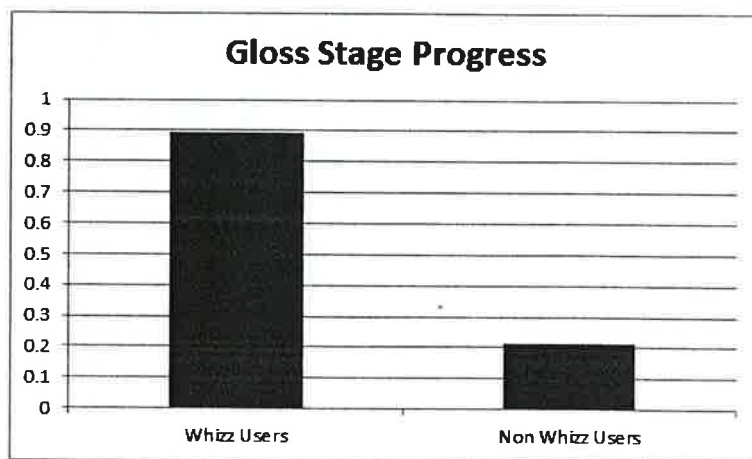

EDUCATIONAL UPDATE - Maslow's theory of the hierarchy of needs is a widely used study of motivation in organisations, including schools. According to Lunenburg and Ornstein (1996), Maslow identified five basic groups of human needs that emerge in a specific sequence or pattern. Once one need is satisfied, another emerges and demands satisfaction. The five levels of need, which represent the order of importance to the individual, are physiological, safety and security, social, esteem, and self actualisation. The needs from lowest to highest level are:

1. **Physiological needs** include the basics of food, water, sleep, oxygen and the like.
2. **Safety and security needs** include the need for physical safety, avoidance of anxiety, order, structure, and job and financial security.
3. **Social needs** include the need for belonging to groups, friendship, and acceptance by others.
4. **Esteem needs** include the need for self-respect, appreciation and recognition from others.
5. **Self-actualisation needs** include the desire for maximizing one's own potential, autonomy, and creativity.

Morale is closely related to the hierarchy of needs because if the physiological, safety and social needs are not met then we are generally not likely to have a positive morale. In relation to children, only when these basic needs are met, can they shift their emphasis to fulfilling their esteem, and self actualization needs.

Bus Changes – If you have shifted house over the holidays or require updates to be made to your child's permanent bus arrangements please contact the office. There are forms and a drop box available for parents to record any changes to bus travel. Office staff will clear the drop box on a daily basis.

Money for School Activities - Children bringing money to school to pay for activity fees/camps or trips will be required to send payments to school in a sealed envelope/plastic bag with their name, room number and what the money is for. There is a drop box in the hall by lost property and children will put their money in this box for the office staff to clear on a daily basis.

Second Hand Uniforms - Any parent wishing to sell their second hand uniform items at school should first label the garments with their name, phone number and price before leaving them at the office. Staff have other priorities and will no longer be doing this on behalf of parents.

Children will be encouraged to use the student entrance to gain access to the office. Students arriving at school that need to come to the office should drop their bags at their classrooms first and use the student entrance by the Junior Boys Toilets. The small counter outside the sickbay has been designed specially to service the students.

A huge thank you to parents who donated handy towels for the sick bay last year. We are always appreciate of this donation as it has cut down our costs and enabled us to buy more first aid necessities.

Parents, volunteers and visitors to the school between the hours of (8:55-2:45) are required to sign in at the office and obtain a VISITORS pass before proceeding into the school grounds. Please also report to the office to get a pink slip to remove children from class. No child will be allowed to leave the school grounds without this permission from the office.

Head Lice - With the children returning to school and sitting closely with other students, we are asking parents to be vigilant for head lice. Children are required to wear swimming caps in the pool and to tie back long hair in order to keep the spread of lice down.

Zero Waste Policy - Please remember that our school is a zero waste school. All food and paper rubbish from morning tea and lunches will be sent home with the children.

School Donations - Thank you to all our parents who have paid the school donation. This funding aids in assisting us to get the additional resources required to run our amazing school.

Sun Smart - As part of our sun smart policy all MBS students are required to wear a sun hat during term 1. If your child does have a hat or is wearing a non-uniform hat, they are to take their lunch and eat around by the juniors in the covered area for all of lunchtime. Please ensure your child has the correct MBS Sun hat for this term.

Maths Whizz - We have recently completed a comparison of our school wide Mathematics data and the use of Whizz to determine if the programme is aiding in building better mathematicians. The data is conclusive that Maths Whizz, when used for 30-60 minutes per week, is improving the mathematical ability of students. We encourage all our families to take up the opportunity offered by investing in Maths Whizz for \$40 per year. We will be using Whizz as part of our maths rotation as we believe it to be extremely supportive in providing maintenance and revision of key concepts.

After School Care - After School care is available at the school three days per week - Tuesday to Thursday. The cost to enrol for a session from 2:45pm - 5:30pm is \$15.00. Enrolment forms are available from the school office.
