What an amazing couple of weeks we have had at MBS. The children have settled into their new classes and routines with ease. We have a new vision statement for Mangawhai Beach School, "Engaged and diverse learners connected to our community and values". We will be unpacking the new vision with staff and students over the year and embedding the core values into our school daily life. We had a wonderful turnout at our new parents morning tea on Thursday. It is always great to be able to answer any concerns or issues raised at these meetings. Please remember that if you have any concerns a quick call to the office can often alleviate them.

Traffic congestion: Please be careful during drop off and pick up times at MBS. The traffic has almost tripled over the years and these times are when we need to be most vigilant. Please give way to all children walking on the footpaths, listen to the instructions of the teachers and DO NOT walk through the car park area, unless you are picking up your car. The best route to travel when heading down the road is through the waharoa and either over our pedestrian crossing or down the footpath. Thank you for your consideration and respect of our traffic rules.

Because of this congestion, we are encouraging more parents to have their child/children walk away from school rather than parents coming to the school for pickups. One great suggestion recently is that children walk down Kedge Drive then Halyard Way through the walkway into Leslie Street to meet parents parked at the church. There is lots of room for parents to park, the walk is a safe one down dead end streets. Please try this alternative with your child and also meeting them at the Domain to help ease congestion on Insley Street during peak times.



School swimming sports: The senior swimming sports for selected 7 year old students and all students from year 5-8 is on Tuesday 27th February at Rodney College swimming pool. There will be a number of non-competitive events for our non-swimmers. Swimming begins at 10:00am. If the weather looks bad we will postpone to another date.

Family Beach Day: Our new annual event, the Family Beach Day, is on at the surf beach this Friday 23rd February from 4:30pm till 6:00pm. This is a day to bring your children to the beach to have a few organised beach day activities with the teachers of MBS. We will begin with a sandcastle competition, then a bury your dad or mum to design a merman or mermaid, a tug of war comp, finishing with a swim and a game of beach cricket. I have heard that there may be a lolly scramble as well. **This is not a drop off event** - It is a time to spend some quality time with your children and the staff of MBS. We have also organised a **BUS** to leave MBS at 4:15pm to drop off at the surf beach. Pick up will be at 6:00pm from the beach to return to the MBS carpark. Last year the surf car park was very full and people couldn't find a park so this year we have organised a bus. SEE YOU ALL THERE!

MORE VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED – FULL TRAINING GIVEN.

The Perceptual Motor Programme (PMP) is a step-by step programme, designed and individualised for the development of PERCEPTUAL KNOWLEDGE and JUDGEMENT.

PMP is a programme which aims to develop the child's perceptions and understandings of himself or herself in relation to her/his world, through movement/motor experiences. It aims to develop perceptions of height and space, the pattern and order of the child's natural world and the laws and limitations that govern the human body. Above all it aims to give the child confidence to manipulate him/herself in their world to suit her or his own best interests.

If you can spare a couple of hours on Thursdays to assist with this programme, please contact the school office and leave your name and contact details.

With more than 300 students to organise on buses in the afternoon, it is important that the office keeps an accurate check list of children riding the bus home in the afternoon in case of an accident or emergency. 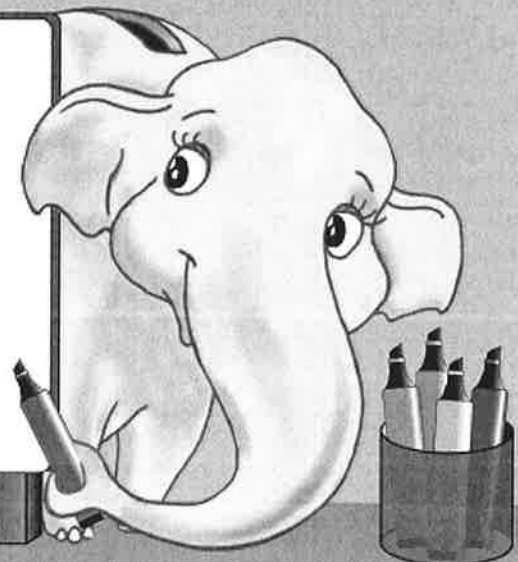

Support for children having difficulty learning



Te Arahi

The Ministry of Education's Learning Support Service (previously known as Special Education) has been working with your Schools/Kura, Early Childhood, Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whātua and Te Uri o Hau to provide better support to children who need additional help with their learning. We are trialling a different way of working so that children who need additional support, access this as quickly as possible. Difficulties with learning might include language and learning delay, social and emotional difficulties, behaviour and wellbeing.

What is happening?

We have set up Support Hubs (called Te Manawa Tahī) in various locations in your community. Te Manawa Tahī have specialists available so you can discuss your concerns directly with them, and determine what may be required to help. Te Arahi will be flying on a flag outside each Te Manawa Tahī venue.

When is this happening?

Please see the timetable overleaf for information on when and where Te Manawa Tahī will be in your community.

From 9:30 am to 12:30 pm Te Manawa Tahī can be visited by appointment. You can ring and make an appointment by calling 0800 KAHUI AKO (0800 52484 256) or your School / Kura / Early Childhood centre can make an appointment for you. You can also email us at learningsupport.twincoast@education.govt.nz or visit our Facebook page "Te Manawa Tahī Twin Coast" and keep an eye out for our updates and helpful resources.

If you want to drop in to Te Manawa Tahī without an appointment you can do so from 1:00 pm to 2:30 pm.

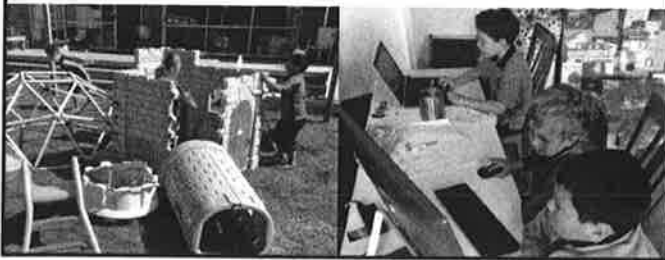

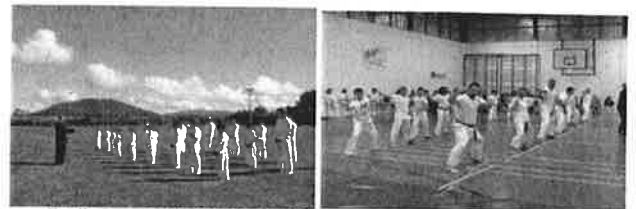
