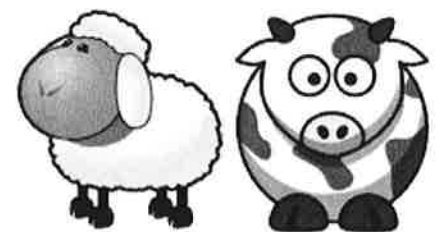

GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING

Head Lice. School Holidays is a good time to get on top of head lice infestations. Please continue to check your child's hair over the holidays and treat if required for a minimum of three weeks in order to kill live pests and their eggs that will hatch during the following weeks. Tea tree oil is a natural alternative that can be added to household shampoos and conditions and also applied directly to the hair. It is important that long hair is tied back to help avoid hair contact with other students.
