Visiting the School Grounds. If you are visiting the school for any reason you need to first sign in at the school office and obtain a visitors pass.

Kiwi Release


On April 21st between 11.00 and 11.30 we are hoping to have a visit from DOC and some kiwis. These birds

are being released into the foothills of the Brynderwyns and will join the birds which have previously been released there. DOC will bring the birds to school on their way to the release site so that the children can see them, receive a talk about them, and some may be lucky enough to touch the birds. The children have been given the privilege of naming two of the birds. You are most welcome to attend this event at school. The school will assemble on the front courts to welcome the birds.




