Welcome back to Term 2. We have another action-packed term planned for our students so please keep up-to-date by joining our Facebook page, reading your seesaw posts from teachers and of course up-dating your calendars via the fortnightly updates and newsletters.

I have spoken on numerous occasions about the issues regarding Insley Street and traffic concerns in the morning and after school. Please be considerate of others, and especially our students, at these busy times. Our school is no longer the 200 students it once was - we now are bordering on 500 students. We are in discussion with the council about providing appropriate pathways and crossings to assist our students getting safely to and from school. A way in which our parent community could help is to complete a quick service request online via the council website. Follow these easy steps:

- Go to www.kaipara.govt.nz
- Scroll to the bottom of the page
- Click on the green 'online requests'
- Click on 'report a problem'
- Complete the form.



Our main issues are we need a pedestrian crossing on Insley Street and a footpath through the carpark at the Four Square by Bammas. Also more signage would help - the bright 40km speed signs would be suitable. Please help us help your children get home safely.

We have had a number of trees on the western boundary of the school removed during the holiday break. The trees have been turned into mulch that is in behind the Kindergarten. Geoff our caretaker will not be using all the mulch so if you would like a trailer load for \$15 please phone the office 09-431 4385 to book in a pickup time.

We recently completed our PAT (Progressive Achievement Tests) standardised assessments in mathematics and reading comprehension for Years 4-8, and Maths for Year 3 late in term one. This is to set a benchmark and provide us with data to assist your child in their learning development over the year. The teachers are uploading this data to Seesaw for you to see and will give more information regarding this test at our parent teacher interviews or earlier if you would like to discuss the test in more detail with them. As a school we did extremely well in both reading and mathematics and were above the 75% benchmark set by the school. An important note is that a large number of our students sat tests higher than their age due to their ability - amazing!

Learning Support

The Ministry of Education's Learning Support (previously known as Special Education) Service and Resource Teachers: Learning and Behaviour (RTL8) have been working with your Schools/Kura, Early Childhood, Te Rōnanga o Ngāti Whātua and Te Uri o Hau to provide better support for children. We are trialling a different way of working so that children who need additional support, access this as quickly as possible.

What is happening?

We have set up Support Hubs (called Te Manawa Tahī) in various locations in your community. If you have a concern about your child's language development, learning progress, social and emotional wellbeing, or behaviour, Te Manawa Tahī have specialists available so you can discuss your concerns directly with them. Through this discussion we will determine what help may be required and identify next steps.

How can you find us?

Te Arahi will be flying on a flag outside each Te Manawa Tahī venue.

When is this happening?

Please see the timetable overleaf for information on when and where Te Manawa Tahī will be in your community.

From 9:30 am to 12:30 pm Te Manawa Tahī can be visited by appointment. You can ring and make an appointment by calling 0800 KAHUI AKO (0800 52484 256) or your School / Kura / Early Childhood centre can make an appointment for you. You can also email us at learningsupport.twincoast@education.govt.nz or visit our Facebook page "Te Manawa Tahī Tai Tokerau" and keep an eye out for our updates and helpful resources.

If you want to drop in to Te Manawa Tahī without an appointment you can do so from 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm.

GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING



In case of emergency: If a situation arises during the day that will change your child's home time routine, we can send a 'green note' to the classroom to advise your child of this change. Please note this service is not for everyday reminders. Please reaffirm after school arrangements with your child in the morning so reminders are not necessary.

School Uniforms: Uniform items are sold every Wednesday. You are welcome to come and try on if your child needs a bigger size or just purchase outright. If you would prefer to order and pay online, please send an email to office@mangawhaibeach.school.nz detailing the size, items required and pay directly into the school account (12-3094-0106669-01) with your child's name and 'uniform' as a reference. Garments will be sent home with your child.

Absences. Please advise the office before 9:30am if your child/children are not attending school on any given day. The Ministry of Education requires the reason for the absence. You can either leave a message on our answering service 09-431-4385 or text the school mobile 0223957708. **YOU MUST CONTACT THE SCHOOL EACH DAY YOUR CHILD IS AWAY.**

School Buses. Buses are provided to take children to and from their home not to after school sports/arts or friend's houses. With more than 300 students to organise on buses in the afternoon, it is important that the office keeps an accurate check list of children riding the bus home in case of an accident or emergency. Please let the office know if your child is not on their normal bus in the afternoon **before 2:00pm.**

Visiting the School Grounds. If you are visiting the school for any reason you **MUST** log in first at the school office and obtain a visitors pass – this is a health and safety requirement.

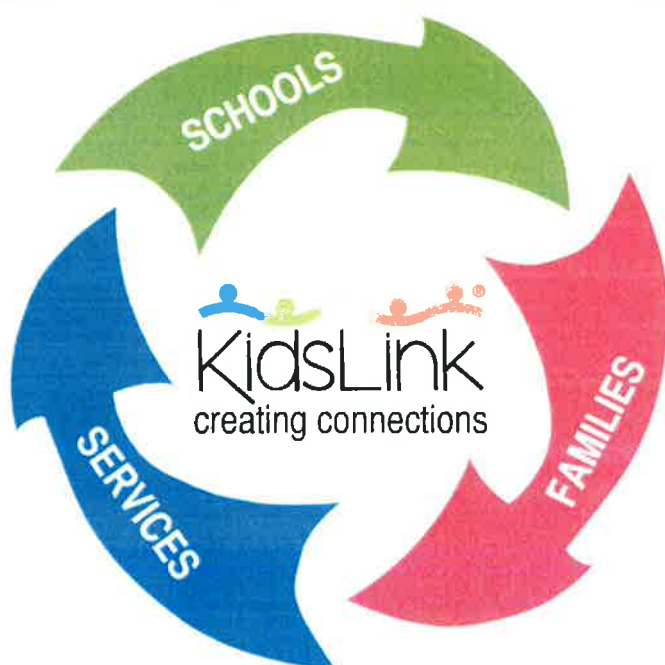
