Welcome back to all our parents, whanau and students. 2021 is going to be a fantastic year and we have lots in store for our students. Our building projects are well underway and we should be in our new classrooms in June. Our middle school students will be moving from the portacombs into the new classrooms - exciting for them!. The concrete bike track has been completed. We will be using this within the next few weeks. We just want to get the expectations organised and the markings for direction completed before we put the children on the track. Each syndicate will get a day to use the track, so bikes, scooters and skateboards will be a go with **HELMETS COMPULSORY**. The kayak storage containers have been placed on the school site. We are organising a cover for the containers, new paint and still need to purchase the sit-on kayaks. If you have any recommendations regarding kayaks please contact me directly to discuss this.

The front entry to the school has raised a few concerns and I can confirm that the Ministry has this well in hand. We have a new turning bay for our buses to keep the 400 plus students who travel to school by bus safe when arriving and leaving the school. Our drainage has been upgraded, new decks built out the back of room 14 and 15 and additional water tanks installed. Our caretaker will soon be getting a new shed as this and the portacombs will be removed from the staff car park once the classrooms are finished, and you will be pleased to know that we will be starting to fundraise for a **new swimming pool** - it is all go at MBS! Go the Fun Run!



I am really pleased to announce that we have a school van. The van is a 12 seater and has been sponsored by Mike Pero Mangawhai. Alan and Jill Corkin have supported the school with a huge sponsorship and we are so grateful for their generous support of MBS. We will be using the van for Kiwi conservation trips, Waka Ama trips, EOTC events and general transport in and around Mangawhai. If you are wanting to contact your child's classroom teacher at any time, you can do so through Seesaw or refer to our school website where all staff email addresses can be found. All information around our processes are in the 'Be a Part of Our CREW' guide you received at your interview.

Their first day of the year will be **Thursday 11th February** so if you would like to order a school lunch for your child please do so, through Kindo, before Thursday. School Leavers: If your family is leaving MBS and moving to another school that does not use Kindo for school payments, you need to close your account. If you're not sure about the new school, log in, go to My Details and click on the list of schools, scrolling to find your new school. If your new school is NOT on the list, use the 'close account' button on that screen. You can choose to donate your balance to school (where available) or have it paid out to your nominated bank account. To ensure parents update room numbers, **Kindo has removed all saved classrooms so you will need to re enter your child/children's classrooms for 2021.**

Thank you for your continued support and patience as our classroom construction continues. There will occasionally be disruptions to drop off and pick up areas in the car park as building materials are delivered. We encourage you to find parking down the road and walk your child/children to school and thank you for your understanding as we try to manage these challenges the best we can.

KINDO is our preferred method of receiving payments from our families. Next time you need to order a uniform item, pay an activity fee or pay for a tuckshop item, it's easy to make the payment and you can see at a glance what you have already paid for.

In case of emergency: If a situation arises during the day that will change your child's home time routine, we can send a 'green note' to the classroom to advise your child of this change. **Please note this is not for everyday reminders.**

Reaffirm after school arrangements with your child in the morning so reminders are not necessary and keep transport arrangements consistent so as not to

confuse your child. We recommend you mark your child's hand with a B for bus or WB for walking bus to help your child remember.

School Uniforms: MBS has a uniform and a uniform policy that we adhere to. Students are expected at school in full and correct uniform. If students arrive in non uniform items, a note from you explaining why the child is out of uniform is expected. You are requested to order your uniform items through KINDO.

School Buses. Buses are provided to take children to and from their home not to after school activities or friend's houses for playdates. Please let the office know if your child is not on their normal bus in the afternoon **before 2:00pm.**



Absences. Please advise the office before 9:30am if your child/children are not attending school on any given day. The Ministry of Education requires the reason for the absence. You can either email, leave us a message on our answering service 09-431-4385 or text the school mobile 0223957708. **YOU MUST CONTACT THE SCHOOL EACH DAY YOUR CHILD IS AWAY.**

Recycle Mobile Phones. The school has a collection box for old mobile phones. Phones collected help our school gain valuable rewards and also the environment benefits by keeping our landfills free of mobile phones and their array of hazardous toxic substances. Please drop any unwanted mobile phones you may have in the collection box in the office.



Head Lice. We are expecting that you are checking your family regularly for head lice and treating if there is evidence of head lice. You will need to continue to treat for three weeks in order to completely break the life cycle.

Visiting the School Grounds. If you are entering the school grounds for any length of time, please sign in at the school office and obtain a visitors pass – this is a health and safety requirement.

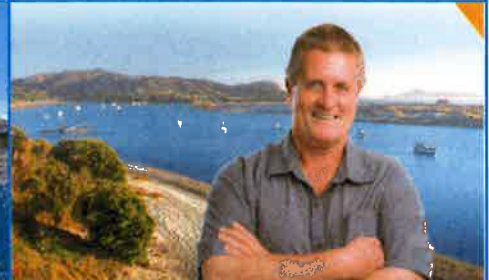
