I know you are all wised up about how the media can inflate the bad behaviour of a few and make it sound like everyone does this. I am sure I can vouch for our local farmers in saying that this sort of practice does not happen in our area and



that if they had rough truck drivers come to their farms, like the ones shown, they would have reported it to the trucking company. This reminds us of how important it is for us to teach our children to become critical thinkers of what they see and hear. So much of the information we get bombarded with on a daily basis is to persuade us to think in a particular way or for a particular cause. Critical thinking and doing your own research can never be a bad thing. The dairy farmers I know have names for their cows and animal health and welfare is their top priority. They spend time walking in the paddocks with their stock, talking to them, and patting them so that they are quiet and easy to handle in the cowshed when they calve. They are their investment and asset. If you were at our Ag Day you will have seen examples of the beautiful healthy young stock that are on our local farms. You don't get stock like that by maltreatment. If you want to know more about our local farmers I can put you in touch with some of them.


