**Bus Eligibility:** A reminder that as of 23<sup>rd</sup> July, buses will not be available to transport children to parent's work place, after school activities, after school care or caregivers addresses. **Buses are only available for travel from home to school and school to home and if you live more than 3.2km from school.** If you are a regular bus user and catch the bus from home to school and back again things will remain unchanged for you.

If you did not receive the letter sent home last week about these changes, you are either not eligible to catch a bus or you are not a regular bus user. Those on a designated bus route who do not currently take advantage of this bus service may do so anytime by contacting the school office.
