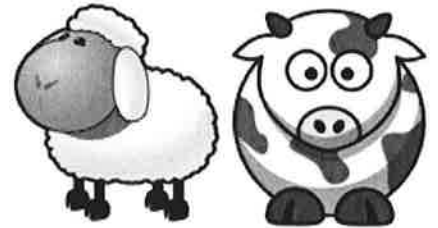
## **AGRICULTURE AND GALA DAY – 24<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2015**
