You may have heard or read recently the proposal by the National Party in New Zealand to require schools to allocate a certain amount of time to Reading, Writing, and Maths Some argue instruction and to introduce new assessments. that this policy could help improve educational outcomes for students by ensuring they receive adequate instruction and monitoring their progress. Others disagree with this proposal, citing concerns that national testing has not been effective in improving student outcomes in the past. At Mangawhai Beach School we have always dedicated key instruction time to the core curriculum subjects of Reading, Writing and Mathematics and have had great results in assessments because of the quality of teaching provided. We use assessment to target learning to our students. It is not assessment only that helps students learn, it is great teaching. Let's remember this and support our students to learn both at home and at school with the best teacher educators and the best parenting support.

We have managed to get in some EOTC beach activities as well as some offsite sports days with more settled weather. Hopefully those activities that we cancelled can be rescheduled for later in the year. Thank you to the staff who organise and parents/caregivers that offer support at these events.
