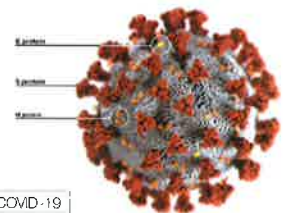

## PRINCIPAL'S SOAPBOX

### TEACHER ONLY DAY - 3RD JULY - SCHOOL CLOSED

**Property Update:** We are about to move into a myriad of property changes for our kura (School). To keep you fully informed the main build of ten classrooms is due to start after the Term 1 holidays and continue for up to a year. We will be having a working bee on the 4th April to remove the existing Junior playground. We are also beginning a new upgrade on the existing field to an astroturf and adding a new Junior playground. Once we have fundraised for the new bike track then this will also be added. In addition to this we are fundraising for a boat shed and other playground equipment for the Intermediate area. New decks are being placed around Room's 13-15 and we are hopeful of adding a covered play area. Please be patient and flexible with us around parking and play areas. We are doing our best to replace current equipment with the same or better for our students.

**Covid-19:** We receive regular updates from the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health on the pandemic that is spreading throughout the world and will be following their recommendations to help prevent the spread of this virus. We trust that our school community is taking this seriously as well and following the Government's instruction to self-isolate when you return from any travel abroad.



**Students picked up from afternoon bus lines:** Please be aware that ALL bus students being picked up before their bus departs in the afternoon must be officially signed out in the office and the person uplifting the student **MUST collect a 'pink slip'** from the office. You must show this slip to the duty teacher before the child will be permitted to leave the school grounds. Please also ensure that the person collecting your child is on the authorised list you have provided the school to enable them to uplift your child.

**Tsunami Drill:** The Tsunami drill on the 26th of March is not a full evacuation drill but more an assembly point drill.



We have 141 runners signed up and have so far raised \$13,000! This is our major fundraiser for the year and with the rest of the students on board we are sure to exceed our fundraising target. We are running it differently this year and organising the prize pool ourselves. For every \$10 raised students receive a token, the more tokens collected the more chances they have in a prize draw. 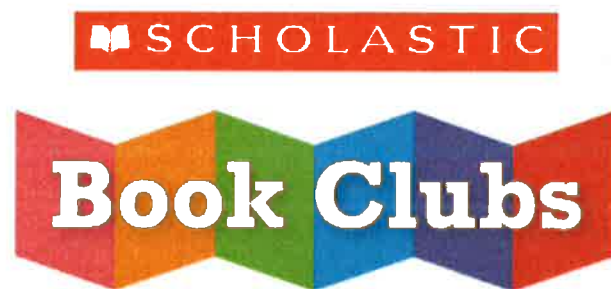

## GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING

**KINDO** is our preferred method of receiving payments from our families. If you haven't already registered please do so via the link of our website or our SchoolApp. Next time you need or order a uniform item or pay for tuckshop treats, it's easy to make the payment and you can see at a glance what you have already paid for. You can also upload payments to your Kindo account to pay off in installments.

**Visiting the School Grounds.** If you are visiting the school for any reason you **MUST** sign in first at the school office and obtain a visitors pass – this is a health and safety requirement.

**In case of emergency:** If a situation arises during the day that will change your child's home time routine, we can send a 'green note' to the classroom to advise your child of this change. **Please note this is not for everyday reminders.** Reaffirm after school arrangements with your child in the morning so reminders are not necessary and keep school arrangements consistent so as not to confuse your child.

**School Uniforms:** Uniform shop is open every **WEDNESDAY**. You are welcome to come and try on Wednesday if your child needs another size or just purchase outright anytime through our school shop and the item will be sent home.

**School Buses.** Buses are provided to take children to and from their home not to after school activities or friend's houses for play dates. Please let the office know if your child is not on their normal bus in the afternoon **before 2:00pm.**



**Absences.** Please advise the office before 9:30am if your child/children are not attending school on any given day. The Ministry of Education requires the reason for the absence. You can either send us a notification through our SchoolApp, leave a message on our answering service 09-431-4385 or text the school mobile 0223957708. **YOU MUST CONTACT THE SCHOOL EACH DAY YOUR CHILD IS AWAY.**

**Recycle Mobile Phones.** The school has a collection box for old mobile phones. Phones collected help our school gain valuable rewards and also the environment benefits by keeping our landfills free of mobile phones and their array of hazardous toxic substances. It is estimated that each year up to three million phones become obsolete and of those, only 2% are recycled. Please drop any unwanted mobile phones you may have in the collection box in the office.



**Head Lice.** We are expecting that you are checking your family regularly for head lice and treating if there is evidence of head lice. You will need to continue to treat for three weeks in order to completely break the life cycle. Please do not bring your nits to school.

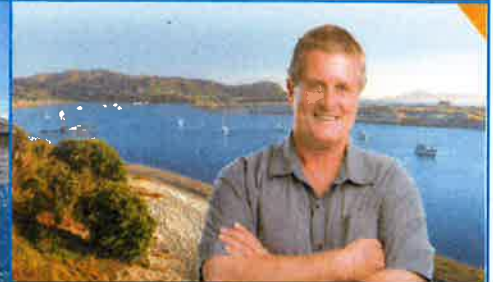
