PRINCIPAL'S SOAPBOX

Welcome back to the start of another term. We hope you have enjoyed your holidays and made some good memories. If you travelled outside of NZ, we hope you had a safe trip.

We have many exciting and interesting events coming up for term two, with the most exciting being the moving of our middle and some senior classes into the new building. Our classes are hopefully moving in on and around the 8th June with our official opening of the new building on the 30th June. It has been a long process with many hurdles along the way, one being the loss of our internet today, however, it will be wonderful to get our students into the new build as many of them have been in substandard classrooms for close on three years. As a Board of Trustees we are currently working with the Ministry of Education on our future classrooms and have been told three of the temporary ones will be remaining on site to assist with roll growth - this is not a good long term solution so we are hopeful of a quick reassessment of our future needs by the MOE. With the new build we have just established our concrete pathways, grassed areas around the one tree that we managed to save, and will start on our fencing project. There will be some plantings along the front of the school to break up the vastness of concrete. We are however waiting for the project to be finished before pressing ahead with this. The next part of the project is to complete the internal building, erect the new caretaker's shed out the back of the school and begin the staff car park. We will continue to have disruptions for the remainder of the year so please bear with us as we move into winter. We will be continuing with our pick off and drop off at the gym car park to ease congestion along Insley Street.

Last term we had some complaints from our Insley Street neighbours about parking. Some of our parents are parking too close to driveways either impeding access in and/or obstructing the view of residents trying to get out of their driveway. Local authorities have been advised so please park appropriately to avoid infringements. When our classrooms are completed the port-a-coms will be removed and the staff car park reinstated which will mean there will be more parking available around the school.

We are now ready to knuckle down and get into some term two learning. Remember that we will be revisiting our CREW values this term: behaving appropriately and covering our expectations in school. Our school is a safe and welcoming place to learn and we want it to stay that way so there will be consequences for unacceptable behaviour.



Please remember that full and correct uniform should be worn at all times. Black shoes and socks, school jackets or polo fleece.

Undergarments are permitted on those cooler mornings but these must also be black. All students with long hair must have it tied back to avoid the spread of head lice and to keep hair out of faces during learning time.

Some key dates to record this term will be the blessing of our new classrooms (8th June) and the official opening of the building (30th June). Also our fundraising Band Night on the 3rd of July is sure to be a winner with our parents.

We have 34 new students starting this week and we are excited to have them at MBS. A Powhiri will be held on Tuesday 11th May at 9:15am to welcome them and their families to MBS and everybody is welcome.

NOTE

In case of emergency: If a situation arises during the day that will change your child's home time routine, we can send a 'green note' to the classroom to advise your child of this change. **Please note this is not for everyday reminders.**

Reaffirm after school arrangements with your child in the morning so reminders are not necessary and keep transport arrangements consistent so as not to

confuse your child. We recommend you mark your child's hand with a B for bus or WB for walking bus to help your child remember.

School Uniforms: MBS has a uniform and a uniform policy that we adhere to. Students are expected at school in full and correct uniform. If students arrive in non uniform items, a note from you explaining why the child is out of uniform is expected. You are requested to order your uniform items through KINDO.

School Buses. Buses are provided to take children to and from their home not to after school activities or friend's houses for playdates. Please let the office know if your child is not on their normal bus in the afternoon **before 2:00pm.**



Absences. Please advise the office before 9:30am if your child/children are not attending school on any given day. The Ministry of Education requires the reason for the absence. You can either email, leave us a message on our answering service 09-431-4385 or text the school mobile 0223957708. ***YOU MUST CONTACT THE SCHOOL EACH DAY YOUR CHILD IS AWAY.***

Recycle Mobile Phones. The school has a collection box for old mobile phones. Phones collected help our school gain valuable rewards and also the environment benefits by keeping our landfills free of mobile phones and their array of hazardous toxic substances. Please drop any unwanted mobile phones you may have in the collection box in the office.



Head Lice. We are expecting that you are checking your family regularly for head lice and treating if there is evidence of head lice. You will need to continue to treat for three weeks in order to completely break the life cycle.

Visiting the School Grounds. If you are entering the school grounds for any length of time, please sign in at the school office and obtain a visitors pass – this is a health and safety requirement.
