Reports

The reports are also designed to give you an overview of how well your child is doing in relation to effort and the Key Competencies. All parents know that children progress at different rates and according to their own unique abilities and talents. The importance focus is that each child is making sustained progress and that we as a school are meeting the needs of each learner. When you receive your child's report at the end of the term I would encourage you to read it in the context of their own personal learning journey in order to celebrate their successes, gain insight into their progress to date and continue to give them positive messages about the challenges ahead.

GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING

Head Lice. Head Lice continue to be a problem in some syndicates with students being reinfected on a regular basis. Reinfection occurs when treatments are not done according to directions or not at all. If you get a class letter home to say that head lice has been found in the class PLEASE check your child and treat if required for a minimum of three weeks in order to kill live pests and their eggs that will hatch during the following weeks. Tea tree oil is a natural alternative that can be added to household shampoos and conditions and also applied directly to the hair. It is important that long hair is tied back to help avoid hair contact with other students.

Visiting the School Grounds. If you are visiting the school for any reason you need to first sign in at the school office and obtain a visitors pass.

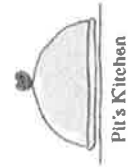
Beach FM 87.8 - The student led radio station will be blasting every lunchtime. Please remember to tune in and listen to our students read stories, play music and practice their DJing skills.

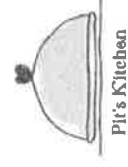

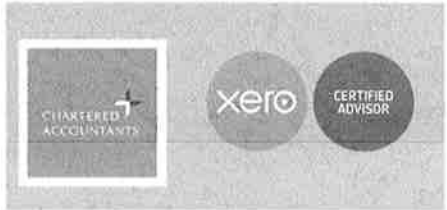
